



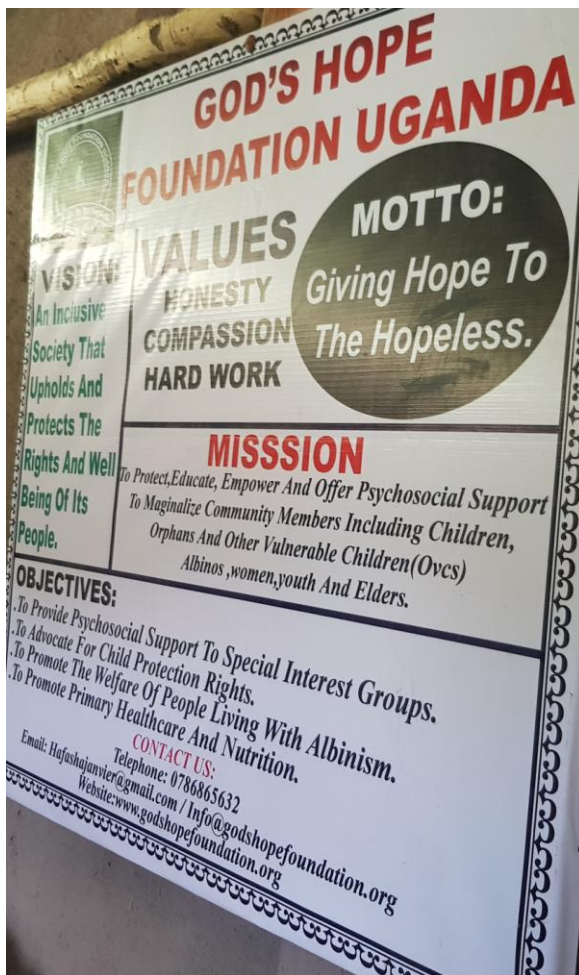

God's Hope Foundation Uganda GHOF-UG is a refugee led Non- governmental organization registered under number **80020003013239** with the government of Uganda. It advocates for physical cognitive and socio-economic development of marginalized people such as albinos & refugees.

GHOF-UG majorly targets vulnerable children, Women and elders

Vulnerable women

Most of the women we work with are widows who lost their spouses as they were fleeing to Uganda, this was because of the war between 1996 to date of M23 and other rebel groups especially in DRC and many of them have 2-5 orphans.



Some women are SGBV survivors of wars as they were raped ,some are disabled and some live with chronic diseases of cancer, HIV/AIDS ,heart pressure and others have PTSD.

Marginalized children

Some of these are unaccompanied refugee minors, these are children who escaped war and departed ways with their parents because of war. We identify them and assessment then bring them at God's hope centre.



Others are children with disabilities, some got disability during the war, and others were born with disabilities because of their mothers who lived in war zones that affected them, hence giving birth to children with disabilities.

We have cases of total orphans we are caring for, we have cases of children who lost their mothers during birth due to lack of care in hospitals and being distant of health facilities, these new born babies survive through well-wishers who support them with

monthly milk and we give them to our care takers daily.

Some other children are children under the care of very old grandparents as the parents to the children died during the war .whereas children are from families affected with chronic diseases of HIV/AIDS, cancer and heart pressure.

We have mentioned the above information to know some of the challenges faced by refugees and the beneficiaries that we are supporting.

We want to take this opportunity to appreciate MS Rachael Wheeler for supporting us with 817,500UGX



With Funds she donated to us we managed to use in Chicken project, we have 100 chicken and we have bought more 40 one month old chicks at 550000 UGX shillings making a total of 140 chicken and we remained with the balance of 267500UGX shillings of which we used the money to buy coffee husks to use on floor, one chicken feeder, a drinker and feeds which can feed them for a month

We started chicken project to support malnourished children in the area of our operation, the eggs we get from hens we feed them to the children under our care hence addressing malnutrition and also sell some to get some money to buy school materials for orphans and also for sustainability of the project.

Challenges Encountered

Here in the camp there's a big challenge of water whereby people travel over 15 kilometres to fetch water which is affecting us because chicken needs to drink 3 times a day sometimes they drink water once or twice

a day due to inadequate water in the community.

Conclusion

To solve this we and clean suggest buying a water Tank to keep water at the site to enable chickens and also children have adequate water.

Here in kyaka II refugee camp refugees flee from different countries such as Burundi, Rwanda, Congo, south sudan and a few from Somalia and all these people flee empty handed, most of them especially elders and children have one pair of clothes, they wash at night when they're going to sleep so that in the morning the cloths would dry, Women and young girls use old cloths during their menstrual periods because they can't afford to buy sanitary pads.

Therefore we are concluding requesting to pray for us so that God opens the door for us and also request to recommend to other people, churches, organizations and volunteers that are willing to join us to save the lives of our fellow refugees.
